

TRANSITIONING BACK FROM COVID-19



Children will be picked up from home or
Parents can drop off at the school.
The bus company will be employing all
Department of Health safety procedures
and Social Distancing on the bus.



ONCE AT THE SCHOOL, THE CHILDREN WILL BE ESCORTED BY A TEACHING ASSISTANT TO GET THEIR TEMPERATURE TAKEN

Non-contact thermometers will be used by a trained staff member to ensure your child is well and can enter the school safely.



STUDENTS FEVER FREE WILL GO TO THEIR CLASSROOM

Any individual who presents with a temperature greater than 100°F will return to their parents if they were brought by a parent and must contact their health care provider for assessment and testing.



Children brought by the bus will go to the isolation room to await their families to come to school.



Children must remain at home until fever free for 72 hours.

All children must be picked up from the isolation room as soon as possible within 1 hour.



All classrooms have been sanitized and are ready for your children. Classrooms are sanitized daily to ensure the spread of germs is minimized. All classroom materials that cannot be cleaned will be removed from the room. This includes: Sand and Water Table, Rugs, Puppets, Stuffed Animals, Dress-up Clothing, Fabric Pillows.



Once in the classroom, children will be in small groups called 'Cohorts'. By staying with only 3-4 children, it will minimize their contact with other children which will reduce the spread of germs. Children will remain in their classroom groups throughout the day with limited contact with other children. Classrooms will be arranged to keep children as far apart as possible.



Children will use hand sanitizer before and after each center experience.



Individual boxes will be made for your child with their own crayons, markers, glue, scissors and play-doh. This minimizes the use of shared materials.



Children will not wear a mask unless it is requested by the parent. If families wish to provide a face mask for their children, we will encourage them to wear it but we will not force them. Staff will wear face and clothing coverings.



Children will remain in their classroom for the majority of the day. Playground will be open but walks will be just on the school grounds.



Children will continue to take turns as they use the outside equipment.

Equipment will be sanitized after each classroom use.



BREAKFAST, LUNCH & SNACK WILL BE INDIVIDUALLY PREPARED FOR EACH STUDENT

All staff will wear gloves while serving and cleaning up from the meal. Family style eating and the use of cots will be prohibited during the COVID-19 restrictions.



BATHROOM

Children will continue to be potty trained and we will continue to follow the high sanitizing procedures already in place. All staff will wear gloves while helping children with their toileting.
